<u>Delegation – Morgan Gutek – Water Security Agency (10:05 a.m. – 10:55 a.m.)</u>

Mr. Gutek spoke to council about the water treatment plant and wastewater system and what is required by the province of Saskatchewan outlined in the Permit to Operate both systems. He spoke about the lagoon expansion project which will get underway later this spring and advised council on the need to have a licensed operator for the lagoon. Discussed with Council how hydrant diffusers work and why they are necessary.

## Delegation - Robert Rink (11:00 a.m. - 11:20 a.m.)

Mr. Rink discussed with Council the need for a better separation between the parking area and the beach at the Shores. Council will look into purchasing concrete Jersey Barriers and/or posts so that motorized vehicles cannot enter the beach area, Signage is also needed. The beach needs to be kept sanitary and safe. More garbage stations are needed as well as at least three more buoys to separate the swimming and boating areas.

Glen Greenwood spoke to Council about the excess clay in the Goodsoil gravel pit and made recommendations to council about how to mix with sand to correct the problem.
