Township Road 625 (north of NE 27-62-23-W3)

- c. The contractor, Northern Meadows Golf Course shall be responsible for any damage or debris on private property.
- d. Any trees not removed immediately from the south ditch of Township Road 625 adjacent to the north boundary of Fairway #15 must be totally removed within a 5 year period at Northern Meadows Golf Course expense.
