## Percentage of Value

In 2017 the Saskatchewan government changed the Percentage of Value (POV) on residen-

tial properties and non-arable land. Residential POV increased from 70% to 80%. The POV for non-arable land or pasture increased from 40% to 45%. POV remained unchanged for cultivated agricultural land at 55% and commercial and industrial properties remained at 100% POV. Percentage of Value's are placed on each different property class in order to calculate the taxable assessment.



For example: A residential property with an assessment of \$100 000.00 (POV is 80%) the taxable assessment would be \$80 000.00 for that property. This means the property owner is only taxed on \$80 000.00.



## How to Calculate your Taxes



### How to Calculate your 2017 Municipal Taxes:

Taxable Assessment x Mill Rate x Mill Rate factor ÷ 1,000 + Base Tax = 2017 Municipal Property Tax

**How to Calculate your 2017 School Tax:** 

Taxable Assessment x Mill Rate ÷ 1,000 = 2017 Education Property Tax

2017 Municipal Mill Rate

Remains at 6.35 Mills

#### **2017 Municipal Mill Rate Factors**

All Agricultural—0.50 Mills

Residential—0.50 Mills

All Commercial—3.80 Mills

#### **2017 Education Mill Rates**

Agricultural—1.43 Mills
Residential—4.12 Mills
Commercial (other)—6.27 Mills
Commercial (Resource) - 9.68 Mills
