Municipal Gravel Program

The RM of Beaver River has approximately 323.5 miles of roadways, 126 miles west of the Community Pasture and 197.5 miles east of the Community Pasture.

Every year 200 yards³ per mile is spread on grid roads. Every second year, 100 yards³ of gravel are spread per mile on regular RM roads. Previously, our gravel tested with a 13.8% clay and silt content; we have now lowered that number to improve the gravel quality that is spread.

The municipal gravel program has helped in ensuring continued maintenance of those roads for safe travel by ratepayers and RM visitors. The program will continue to be in effect for 2018 with approximately 20 000 yards³ of gravel secured for spreading this summer.
