## FIRE INSURANCE



Please check with your insurance agent to ensure you are covered for the cost of a fire department responding to a fire on your property. Goodsoil Fire Department and Pierceland Fire Department rates are currently the same.

The RM of Beaver River pays yearly retainer fees in order to provide residents with fire protection services. In 2017, the fire protection retainer paid to the Village of Goodsoil was \$20,000.00 and the Village of Pierceland's retainer fee paid was \$15,000.00.

The dividing line separating the service districts of the Pierceland and Goodsoil Fire Departments is range line #23. The Pierceland Fire Department servicing west of the dividing line and Goodsoil Fire Department servicing the east of the dividing line.

# **2017 ASSESSMENT REVALUATION**

From the above table, one can see that during the re-valuation year of 2017 all assessments increased. In particular:

Non-arable Agland (N) increased a total of 132% Agland (A) increased by 119% Residential (R) increased by 40% Seasonal Residential increased by 37% Commercial & Industrial increased by 6%

In Saskatchewan, property values are updated every four years. A full re-valuation of all properties in the municipality was completed in 2017. The base date for this re-valuation is January 1, 2015.

Every year, the assessment roll is open for 30 days. In re-valuation years the assessment roll is open for 60 days. If you have any questions about your assessment notice or you would like to appeal your assessment you must do so within that time period.

The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) has representatives who perform site visits and calculate all assessment changes for the RM.
