In the absence of a Bylaw Officer, the division councillor shall be appointed as the fire ranger or enforcement officer for their respective divisions. If a councillor is not available, an adjacent councillor shall be appointed as the fire ranger. If neither is available, the reeve shall assume the role of fire ranger.

As soon as possible the administration staff or Meadow Lake Provincial Park fire staff shall notify the district fire ranger of any unauthorized fires burning in their area.

The area fire ranger is responsible for the enforcement of fire bans or permit violations.

The fire ranger is authorized to contract local fire department or any equipment deemed necessary to extinguish fire.

The costs of extinguishing fire shall be charged to the persons who receive the service.

The council may authorize the Administrator to add outstanding invoices for service to the taxes of any property owned by the person receiving the service.
