



RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BEAVER RIVER 622
BYLAW 5/09

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BEAVER RIVER 622 TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF
SCRAP TIRES.

Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in
Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires therefore, the Council of the RM of Beaver River No. 622
in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned or operated landfill located
on the most Southerly 330 feet in perpendicular width throughout if the NE-13-62-26
W3rd.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically
designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. Any person who contravenes the provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon
summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty
Bylaw of the municipality.
