Bylaw No. 5-11

Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 57 known as the Zoning Bylaw

The Council of the R.M. of Beaver River No. 622, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 57 as follows:

1. Schedule D: Lakeshore Development 1 District; Part B. Regulations; Section 6

<u>Accessory Buildings and Structures</u>; (a) <u>Yard Requirements</u> is amended as follows:

Front Yard: Minimum: the minimum front yard requirement for the principle building shall apply; EXCEPT in instances where a residential lot is abutting a lake and there is no Municipal Reserve, Public Reserve or Environmental Reserve between the lot and the lake shore. In such an instance, the front yard requirement for accessory use shall be 3 metres (10 feet).

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.
