Policy Title:	13 Naming of Roads and Streets

- A. Council may approve by RESOLUTION the naming or renaming of Range and Township roadways subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. Applicant must submit a written request for council approval.
 - 2. One name per roadway.
 - 3. RM administrative staff will send a letter to all property owners who border roadway to give them an opportunity to object to the proposed change. All property owners must have no objections. Bordering property owners shall be given 90 days to submit an objection.
 - 4. In addition to any Range or Township Road Sign only one sign may be installed on a post.
 - 5. Signs will be supplied and installed by the RM of Beaver River 622. All costs including administration, advertising, signs and installation will be the responsibility of the applicant.
 - 6. Signs and installation must meet the standards set out in the "Rural Municipal Traffic Signing Manual".
- B. Council may approve by BYLAW the renaming of streets subject to the following conditions:
 - Applicant must submit a written request for council approval.
 - 2. One name per street.
 - 3. RM administrative staff will send a letter to all property owners who border roadway to give them an opportunity to object to the proposed change. All property owners must have no objections. Bordering property owners shall be given 90 days to submit an objection.
 - 4. Renaming of a Street requires amendment to the Approved Plan of Survey,
 - Signs will be supplied and installed by the RM of Beaver River 622. All costs including administration, advertising, Information Services Corporation fees, signs and installation will be the responsibility of the applicant.
 - 6. Signs and installation must meet the standards set out in the "Rural Municipal Traffic Signing Manual".
