- ♦ At the special meeting of council on July 30, 2019, RM council carried a resolution to hire a contractor to cut down any remaining leaning trees at the Lau-man's Landing subdivision , falling them and leaving them where they lay.
- ♦ Since this meeting, Tolko Industries from Meadow Lake has agreed to take all the trees piled at the boat launch. They will be de-limbed and de-stumped on site. The remaining stumps and limbs will be burned sometime this winter.
- ♦ Our maintenance staff have been working hard cleaning up the rest of the subdivision.

Brushing

The RM of Beaver River #622 wishes to support Ratepayers who endeavour to clear brush and other debris from their property lines adjacent to RM roadways to a standard whereby the RM can mow ditches. Circumstances may also develop whereby the RM is endeavouring to carry out roadway improvements. Whereas such brushing and clearing procedures can be mutually beneficial to the Landowner as well as to the RM, the following policy has been established:



That the RM of Beaver River #622 pays \$2,000 per ½ mile under the condition that prior approval is obtained from the Division Councillor before commencement of the project.

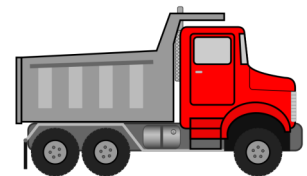
Permission expires within 6 months. Applicant may reapply.
