Council and Reeve Duties at the Rural Municipality

General duties of councillors

92 Councillors have the following duties:

- (a) to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interests of the municipality;
- (b) to participate in developing and evaluating the policies, services and programs of the municipality;
- (c) to participate in council meetings and council committee meetings and meetings of other bodies to which they are appointed by the council;
- (d) to ensure that administrative practices and procedures are in place to implement the decisions of council;
- (e) subject to the bylaws made pursuant to section 81.1, to keep in confidence matters discussed in private or to be discussed in private at a council or council committee meeting until discussed at a meeting held in public;
- (f) to maintain the financial integrity of the municipality;
- (g) to perform any other duty or function imposed on councillors by this or any other Act or by the council.

General duties of mayor or reeve

93(1) In addition to performing the duties of a councillor, a mayor or reeve has the following duties:

- (a) to preside when in attendance at a council meeting unless this Act or another Act or a bylaw of council provides that another councillor is to preside;
 - (b) to perform any other duty imposed on a mayor or reeve by this or any other Act or by bylaw or resolution.
- (2) The mayor or reeve is a member of all council committees and all bodies established by council pursuant to this Act, unless the council provides otherwise.

The Lac des Iles Utility Commission hereby invites tenders from qualified contractors in order to award a contract for the following:

Hauling of waste and wastewater from the Lac des Iles water treatment plant to the sewage lagoon.

Hauling and spreading of clean wastewater on local roads in the summer months to aid in dustproofing those roads. The process of spreading clean waste water on Lauman's and RM roadways requires operator to clean truck septic tanks prior to the loading and spreading of clean waste water.

Please submit tenders indicating a price based **per gallon** hauled.

The approximate fluid volume is 463 000 gallons per year.

Do you own or lease land in an adjoining municipality?

(RM of Meadow Lake #588 or RM of Loon Lake #561)

If so, you are eligible to receive a municipal tax exemption on your permanent residential dwelling as per section 293 of The Municipalities Act.

You must fill out the prescribed form called the "Land Owned or Under Lease Agreement in Adjoining Municipalities". It must be completed with the other RM Administrator's Authorization Signature. You must return the form to the RM of Beaver River's office on or before **January 31st ANNUALLY** to be eligible for this exemption.

This form can be picked up at the RM office or found on our website (www.rmofbeaverriver622.ca) under the Policies & Bylaws tab—General Government—Farmland Exemption Policy.

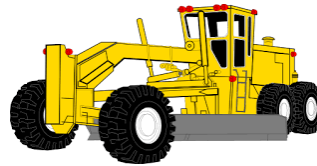
