Brushing of approximately 5 miles of municipal road allowance at various locations throughout the RM of Beaver River.

NOTE: A bulldozer is required. The Contractor shall furnish all labour and equipment to perform the work as specified herein.

Any damage to fences will be the sole responsibility of the contractor. The municipality is not responsible for damage to equipment due to rocks, wire etc. on municipal road allowance. Successful contractor shall erect warning signage at each end of road allowance during brushing.

Contractor shall supply proof of public liability damage insurance and proof of Workplace Safety and Insurance Board coverage to include with price quote.

Do you own or lease land in an adjoining municipality?

(RM of Meadow Lake #588 or RM of Loon Lake #561)

If so, you are eligible to receive a municipal tax exemption on your permanent residential dwelling as per section 293 of The Municipalities Act.

You must fill out the prescribed form called the "Land Owned or Under Lease Agreement in Adjoining Municipalities". It must be completed with the other RM Administrator's Authorization Signature. You must return the form to the RM of Beaver River's office on or before **March 31st ANNUALLY** to be eligible for this exemption.

Florescent Fixtures and Tubes

The Pierceland and Goodsoil Transfer Sites do not accept any florescent light fixtures with ballasts intact. Please remove ballasts, deposit fixture into the metal pile at the transfer site and take ballasts to the Rapid View Landfill for proper disposal.

OR

Take the entire unit to the Rapid View Landfill for proper disposal.

Florescent tubes are not an accepted item at the transfer sites and should be taken to the Rapid View facility as well.



Snow Plowing

The RM of Beaver River can be contracted to snow plow your driveway. Prepaid snow plow flags are available at the RM office for \$40 plus GST. A form must also be filled out authorizing the RM to complete this work. The form is available both at the RM office and on the website under Policies & Bylaws, then click on RM Forms. If you purchase a flag and place it at your driveway entrance the work will be done when the grader is in your area.
