### Delegation #1 (Rick Danilkewich - Lac Des Iles Utility Commission Board Member & Division 4 Ratepayer) - 9:35 AM

Mr. Danilkewich approached Council to inquire about the emergency measures taken by the RM during the recent tornado/wind storm at Lauman's Landing. He questioned what types of events constitute declaring a state of emergency in the RM. He stated that RM Council presence would have been valuable after the storm, providing Lauman's residents with equipment, manpower and traffic control.





Administrator Neufeld stated that the Pierceland RCMP explained that the Province of Saskatchewan stepped in shortly after the storm, dispatching STARs air ambulance, surrounding area ground ambulances and contacting the surrounding hospitals.

Mr. Danilkewich clarified that all Emergency response members were sent to Murray Doelle campground in the Meadow Lake Provincial Park.

Administrator Neufeld explained that she contacted Reeve Rolfes after hearing about the storm to inquire about offering RM equipment, blankets or drinking water etc. Reeve Rolfes called Goodsoil Fire Chief's cellphone to offer RM assistance. The Reeve was told that there was sufficient manpower and equipment present at Lauman's Landing and to stand down. Administrator Neufeld stated that PDAP (Provincial Disaster Assistance Program) funding is on the current meeting agenda.

On behalf of the Lac Des Iles Utility Commission, Mr. Danilkewich asked about the possibility of acquiring ownership of all utility equipment, and infrastructure concerning the Lauman's Landing Subdivision.

The RM Council is supportive of Administration working alongside the Lac Des Iles Utility Commission to obtain information on the process of the change of ownership.

Council thanked Mr. Danilkewich for attending the meeting.
