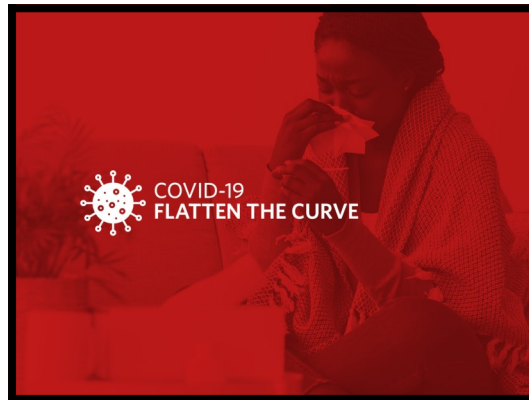


We Are In This Together



A [Self-assessment Tool](#) for COVID-19 is available on the **Saskatchewan.ca** website.

Use this self-assessment tool to determine whether you should be tested for COVID-19.

You can complete this assessment for yourself or on behalf of someone else, if they are not able.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

A referral is required to get tested. You do not need to have travelled internationally to get a referral for testing. If you are not exhibiting symptoms, you do not need to be tested.

You can obtain a referral to a community testing centre by phoning:

HealthLine 811.

Your local Public Health Communicable Disease Control office.

Your family physician.

Your nurse practitioner.

All residents should be familiar with self-monitoring and self-isolation precautions, in order to keep you and those around you safe.

To protect yourself while out in public, wash your hands frequently and maintain a safe distance from others.

OTHER TENDER DETAILS

The contractor shall be responsible to supply all required equipment and pay all associated costs of operating of equipment, etc.

The contractor shall be responsible to supply and pay all associated costs of employees or labor to complete work indicated above.

The contractor shall sign a declaration indicating that all employees or sub-contractors are trained in power mobile equipment operation as per the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

The RM pays all costs associated with Worker's Compensation Board

The contractor shall obtain liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000 (Two million dollars) and shall supply the RM with a copy of liability insurance upon awarding of the tender.

Tender payment shall be paid in four equal installments (in correspondence with Council meetings) due on the following dates: June 18, July 16, August 20 and September 17, 2020.

An equipment list **MUST** be submitted with bid form.

Tender closing date: April 15, 2020 4:00 p.m. CST

LOWEST or not necessarily any tender accepted.

Terms and conditions (including commencement date) are subject to change due to the current COVID pandemic.
