The RM of Beaver River has been awarded funding in the amount of \$9 732.82 from SGI's Provincial Traffic Safety Fund Grant Program. The program provides up to \$100,000 (per location) to municipalities and Indigenous land or territories. The goal of this fund is to stimulate and support local, collaborative action that will increase traffic safety awareness and reduce the frequency and severity of traffic injuries and fatalities within Saskatchewan.

The program began in 2019 and uses funds from photo speed enforcement tickets.

These funds are allocated for the purchase and installation of rubber speed bumps and signage within municipal subdivisions. The goal is to have the speed bumps installed in areas that are predominantly reported for speeding. The RM Maintenance staff will install the bumps as per council direction some time in the spring of 2021.

Saskatchewan's Phased Approach to COVID-19 Vaccination

Widespread Access

Phase 2 is anticipated to begin in April 2021.

It will continue priority population immunization and begin general population immunization.

Distribution will occur throughout the province at public health clinics and other vaccination delivery sites.

Vaccination Sites: The goal is for all residents to be able to access vaccine where they live or work. Vaccinations will be done in LTC and PCH homes in Phase 1. Phase 2 will include mass immunization clinics, and vaccinations by physicians, nurse practitioners, and pharmacists.

Dependent on vaccine availability, sequencing of additional priority populations and general population access will be announced in subsequent planning updates.


Planning for redeployment of public service staff is underway to support administration tasks and data entry at vaccine sites.

Training of public service staff will begin as soon as possible to ensure rapid readiness as needed.

Additional vaccine providers may be engaged, depending upon vaccine availability.

Phase 2 will begin sooner if vaccine supplies allow.

Do you own or lease land in an adjoining municipality?

(RM of Meadow Lake #588 or RM of Loon Lake #561)

If so, you are eligible to receive a municipal tax exemption on your permanent residential dwelling as per section 293 of The Municipalities Act.

You must fill out the prescribed form called the "Land Owned or Under Lease Agreement in Adjoining Municipalities". It must be completed with the other RM Administrator's Authorization Signature. You must return the form to the RM of Beaver River's office on or before March 31st ANNUALLY to be eligible for this exemption.

Snow Plowing

The RM of Beaver River can be contracted to snow plow your driveway. Prepaid snow plow flags are available at the RM office for \$40 plus GST. A form must also be filled out authorizing the RM to complete this work. The form is available both at the RM office and on the website under Policies & Bylaws, then click on RM Forms. If you purchase a flag and place it at your driveway entrance the work will be done when the grader is in your area.

Each flag is only good for one grader visit.
