Property Revaluation Year

Provincial legislation requires all properties in Saskatchewan be revalued once every four years. For the 2021 revaluation, the base date used for assessment values is January 1, 2019. This ensures assessed values are more current, as property values change over time.

Attention Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Members

March 31st, 2021 is the last day to withdraw from SMHI coverage.

Civic Address Signs

Some residents have experienced issues with Emergency Services finding their legal land location in an emergency. Did you know that the RM has a civic addressing policy for your public safety? Supplying your quarter section address will get EMS to your land location but a civic address actually pinpoints your driveway on the adjoining roadway saving valuable time in an emergency.

The application form for a civic address can be found on the RM website, under the Policies and Bylaws tab, then click on RM Forms, Civic Addressing Application Form. You may choose to have your own sign made or civic address signs are available for order through the RM office. A cheque made payable to <u>GPR Signs</u> in the amount of \$55.50 should accompany your application if you want us to order your sign for you.





SaskAlert is the Government of Saskatchewan's emergency public alerting program that provides critical information on emergencies in real time, so you can take action to protect yourself, your family and your property.

Why you should download the SaskAlert app

An emergency alert issued though SaskAlert will:

- let you know what the emergency is;
- let you know where it is happening;
- provide instructions for you to follow to stay safe; and advise you when the incident is over.

Alerts can be issued by: Environment Canada, Government of Saskatchewan ministries, Crowns and agencies as well as participating local governing jurisdictions.

Participation in SaskAlert gives jurisdictions the ability to issue alerts about local emergency events to their residents, visitors and anyone passing through the areas. There is no cost to jurisdictions who would like to participate in the SaskAlert program.

Calls are taken 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You can remain anonymous and may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$2,000 if your information leads to a conviction.



Recreational Property Maintenance Tender

Lac Des Iles Washrooms and Fish Filleting Shacks (Weekends/Holidays ONLY)

This tender is to supply the following maintenance services for the RM of Beaver River No. 622 every Saturday, Sunday and all statutory holidays (Friday and Monday holidays only) for the period commencing on May 22, 2021 to September 6, 2021 inclusive:

RM West Boat Launch (NE 12-63-23-W3) / RM East Boat Launch (SE 17-63-22-W3):

Washrooms

- -must be cleaned and bleached daily
- -empty and remove garbage daily (haul to RM waste collection site)
- -refill paper products as required
- -cleaning products and paper products will be supplied by RM
- -monitor septic tank daily and notify RM when pump out is necessary

Fish Filleting Shack

- -must be cleaned and bleached daily
- -cleaning supplies will be supplied by the RM
- -empty and remove garbage daily (haul to RM waste collection site)
- -remove and haul away fish offal daily to RM waste collection site
- -remove garbage or anything that is not fish offal before disposing in designated area
- -monitor septic tank daily and notify RM when pump out is necessary

c. Miscellaneous

- -RM will be responsible for the winterizing of plumbing and buildings, etc.
- -report any required repairs and potential hazards to the RM office

The Shores MR1 Park:

Washrooms

- -must be cleaned and bleached daily
- -empty and remove garbage daily (haul to RM waste collection site)
- -refill paper products as required
- -cleaning products and paper products will be supplied by RM
- -monitor septic tank daily and notify RM when pump out is necessary

c. Miscellaneous

- -RM will be responsible for the winterizing of plumbing and buildings, etc.

The contractor shall be responsible to supply and pay all associated costs of employees or labor to complete work indicated above.

The RM pays all costs associated with Worker's Compensation Board.

The contractor shall obtain liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000 (Two million dollars) and shall supply the RM with a copy of liability insurance upon awarding of the tender.

Tender payment shall be paid in four equal installments (in correspondence with Council meetings) due on the following dates: June 17, July 15, August 19 and September 16, 2021.

How the Easter date determined every year

First off, it's important to

know that though the exact date of Easter changes each year, there's a definite period in which the day occurs, and that's March 22 through April 25 (in the Gregorian calendar, not the Julian calendar). Easter always occurs on the first Sunday after the Paschal Full Moon (the first full moon that occurs after the vernal equinox, which signifies the beginning of spring in the northern hemisphere), according to *The Old Farmer's Almanac*.

In 2021, the vernal equinox falls on March 20, 2021, making the first full moon after that date March 28 and the following Sunday—April 4— Easter 2021.
