Grader purchase

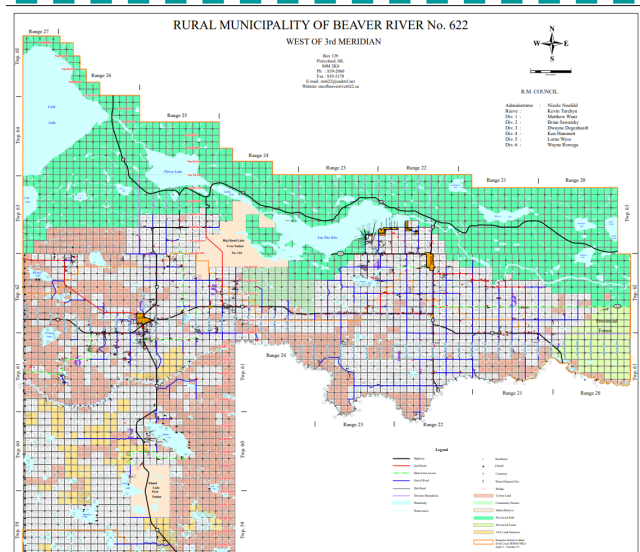

A new grader has joined the RM equipment fleet. It was delivered to the Goodsoil shop on June 28th. The grader was purchased from Brandt Saskatoon for a total of \$487 094.10. This includes a trade in allowance of \$200 000.00 for one 2017 140m Cat Grader.

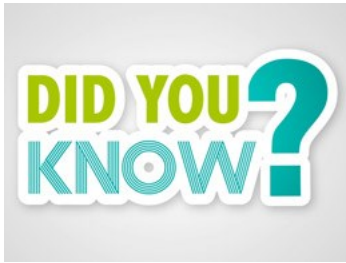
