## BYLAW No. <u>01 - 2022</u>

## A BYLAW OF THE R.M. OF BEAVER RIVER No. 622 TO AMEND BYLAW No. 57 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 57 as follows:

- 1. PART IV ZONING DISTRICTS, SCHEDULE D: LD1 LAKESHORE DEVELOPMENT 1 DISTRIST, B. REGULATIONS, 8. Fences, is amended by deleting clause (a) and replacing it with the following:
  - (a) As a matter of public safety in a residential context, no fence located within or on the boundary of a residential-zoned parcel shall be constructed of stranded wire(s), be electrified, contain barbs or razors, or be made of chain link.
    - (i) Notwithstanding (a), where a chain link fence is coated with a rubberized or plastic material, or it has been treated with weaved slats, it is permitted."
- 2. PART IV ZONING DISTRICTS, SCHEDULE H: LR LAKESHORE RESIDENTIAL (ACREAGE) DISTRICT, B. REGULATIONS, 7. Fences, is amended by deleting clause (a) and replacing it with the following:
  - (a) As a matter of public safety in a residential context, no fence located within or on the boundary of a residential-zoned parcel shall be constructed of stranded wire(s), be electrified, contain barbs or razors, or be made of chain link.
    - (i) Notwithstanding (a), where a chain link fence is coated with a rubberized or plastic material, or it has been treated with weaved slats, it is permitted."
- 3. PART IV ZONING DISTRICTS, SCHEDULE I: LD3 LAKESHORE DEVELOPMENT 3 DISTRICT, B. REGULATIONS, 8. Fences, is amended by deleting clause (a) and replacing it with the following:
  - (a) As a matter of public safety in a residential context, no fence located within or on the boundary of a residential-zoned parcel shall be constructed of stranded wire(s), be electrified, contain barbs or razors, or be made of chain link.
    - (i) Notwithstanding (a), where a chain link fence is coated with a rubberized or plastic material, or it has been treated with weaved slats, it is permitted."

- **4.** PART IV ZONING DISTRICTS, SCHEDULE J: LD4 LAKESHORE DEVELOPMENT 4 MOTOR HOME DISTRICT, B. REGULATIONS, 6. Fences, is amended by deleting clause (a) and replacing it with the following:
  - (a) As a matter of public safety in a residential context, no fence located within or on the boundary of a residential-zoned parcel shall be constructed of stranded wire(s), be electrified, contain barbs or razors, or be made of chain link.
    - (i) Notwithstanding (a), where a chain link fence is coated with a rubberized or plastic material, or it has been treated with weaved slats, it is permitted."

This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval of the Minister of Government Relations.
