

There are four general phases of the Subdivision Process?

There are four general phases of the Subdivision Process which often overlap.

- 1. A landowner works with a professional agent to prepare a plan and submit an application.
- 2. That application is reviewed by an approving authority to determine site suitability and ensure public interest is met. This includes:
 - a. A landowner's compliance with a municipality's official community plan and zoning bylaw.
 - b. Completion of a servicing agreement between a landowner and a municipality for the capital cost to upgrade municipal infrastructure to serve the proposed subdivision.
 - c. Dedication of municipal reserve for public recreational opportunities.
- 3. A decision about whether or not to proceed with a subdivision is issued by an approving authority. In Saskatchewan, the provincial Ministry of Government Relations is the approved authority.
- 4. A landowner registers a survey plan at Information Services Corporation (ISC) and creates the titles for each lot.

Snow Plowing



The RM of Beaver River can be contracted to snow plow your driveway. Prepaid snow plow flags are available at the RM office for \$40 plus GST. A form must also be filled out authorizing the RM to complete this work. The form is available both at the RM office and on the website under Policies & Bylaws, then click on RM Forms. If you purchase a flag and place it at your driveway entrance the work will be done when the grader is in your area.

Each flag is only good for one grader visit.

Pest Control Officer

The Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622 is currently accepting applications for the contract position of <u>Pest</u> Control Officer.

Applicant must:

- 1. Hold a valid Class 5 driver's license;
- 2. Supply their own reliable vehicle; and
- 3. Hold a valid Pesticide Applicator License <u>OR</u> enroll in Structural Applicator (PEST-174) and Rat Control Applicator (PEST-177) courses online through Saskatchewan Polytechnic. All education re-imbursed by the Municipality following confirmation of successful completion.

Specific Duties:

- 1. Inspect all occupied and vacant farm buildings and outside areas to detect signs of infestation at least once annually;
- 2. Neutralize pests through control measures such as pesticide application and baiting;
- 3. Fill out and submit Rat Infestation Reports/PCO Inspection Reports;
- 4. Submit detailed monthly invoices to the Municipality; and
- 5. Maintain a valid Pesticide Applicators License and provide a copy of the license to the Municipality annually.

Personal Suitability:

- Effective interpersonal skills;
- Self motivated;
- Flexible availability; and
- Organized.

Independent Contractor Position. WCB, health or other benefits, income taxes etc. are the responsibility of the PCO.
