

If you apply dust control to the road in front of your property we now have yellow flags available to place at the beginning and end of the dust control placement that will alert our grader operators to change their procedure. These flags are available at the RM office in Pierceland at no cost to the ratepayer.

Calcium Chloride

Please do not apply any calcium chloride dust control products to the RM road adjacent to your property before speaking with the RM office personnel. This is so that any gravelling and grading can be properly coordinated to happen before the dust control is applied.

This is formal notification that it is the intention of Council to consider the passing of a bylaw with respect to the closing of the following road as per Section 13(1)(b)(ii) of the Municipalities Act:

All that portion of roadway H28545 (Plan 101894104), Thunderchild 818.51.2 and H28545 in the following land:

NE and NW 7-59-25-W3, NE 12-59-26-W3, SE and SW 13-59-26-W3, NE and NW 11-59-26-W3, NE and NW 10-59-26-W3, SE and SW-15-59-26-W3 and SE 16-59-26-W3

between the NW 1/4 Section 20-62-21-W3 and the SW 1/4 Section 29-62-21-W3.

Per Section 128(1) of *The Municipalities Act*, notice is hereby given that Council has the intention to consider permanently closing a municipal road pursuant to Section 13 of *The Municipalities Act*.

Did you know beaver dams can be seen from space? Some beaver dams are so massive that satellites can spot them from space, like one in Alberta that is a half mile long!

Baby beavers can swim right after birth.

Beavers have a special gland that produces waterproof oil for their fur, they use their split toenails like combs to spread the oil on their coat.

Beaver tails are rudders when swimming, fat storage for winter and warning signals when slapped on water. Their tail also helps them balance while carrying heavy logs on land.

Beavers have a complex system of tail slaps on water indicating different types of threats. Their slaps create distinct water vibrations that travel far underwater, reaching family members throughout their territory.

Beaver couples mate for life. Parents work together to raise their young. Older siblings help with younger ones and assist with lodge maintenance. Young beavers stay with their parents for two years before starting families of their own.

And...Beaver teeth never stop growing just like human fingernails. The orange color comes from iron in their tooth enamel, making the teeth incredibly strong and decay resistant.
