Gravel Program and Road Maintenance

The Gravelling Program has been completed. There will be a couple of missed spots done yet this fall.

Culvert repairs, ditch and shoulder pulling and road repairs will continue throughout the fall. Please watch for signs and barriers where they are working. A reminder to all ratepayers that unless posted otherwise, the speed limit on rural roads is 80 km. Where roads are being maintained and repair work being done, please drive according to road conditions and slow down appropriately where there are workers.

If you have any road concerns or think we have missed some repair or maintenance, please don't hesitate to contact your councillor or the office. We do appreciate the calls about signs that have been knocked down, rocks that may have surfaced during grading, fallen trees and other issues, It helps us keep our maintenance work list up to date and prioritize what needs to be completed.

Approach Development

Application for approach development must be submitted in writing to the R.M. Office. If the request meets all guidelines and the Reeve and Councillor approve the request, written permission will be issued to the ratepayer. Construction requirements can be obtained from the office. When an approach has been constructed without permission, written notice will be sent to the ratepayer requesting that the approach be brought to standards within 180 days.
