Policy Title:	02 Liquor Permit Policy

Purpose:

- To provide authorization for residents of the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622 (“the RM”) to acquire liquor permits from Saskatchewan Liquor & Gaming Authority (“SLGA”).

Definitions:

“Council” Means Council for the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622.

“The RM” Means the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622.

“SLGA” Means the Saskatchewan Liquor & Gaming Authority.

Scope:

All authorization(s) shall be made in accordance with this policy.

Background:

1. As per SLGA regulations:
 - Any person(s) applying for a license to sell liquor at their establishments, homes, yards, or functions thereon.
 - Anyone holding a function involved in the sale of alcohol must have the land location, date, time, and type of function.
 - The RM in which the property is situated must give their approval to hold such functions.

Policy:

- The Council of the RM authorize the Administrator to provide a letter of approval for any function within the RM of Beaver River No. 622 boundaries with the following stipulations:
 - a) That a letter of request must be completed by the applicant stating:
 - Date and time of bar hours
 - Name
 - Location
- That approval will be given by the Administrator on behalf of Council;
- That the “RM of Beaver River No. 622 does not accept any responsibility for any problem, accident or liability that may arise from the function”.
