BYLAW NO. 05-19

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURES OF
MUNICIPAL FUNDS FOR REPAIRS IN AN EMERGENCY**

Pursuant to section 159 of *The Municipalities Act*, Council of the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short Title

This Bylaw may be cited as The Emergency Expenditures Bylaw.

Interpretation

“emergency” means a present or imminent situation or condition that requires prompt action to prevent or limit:

- (i) loss of life;
- (ii) harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of people; or
- (iii) damage to property or the environment;

Purpose

1. That together, the Administrator and the Reeve are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to public works in an amount not exceeding an aggregate of \$10,000.00 unless approved by Council.
2. The amount and nature of any expenditure for repairs of an emergent nature to public works shall be presented to Council at the next regular Council meeting.
3. Pursuant to Section 1, the Deputy Reeve may provide approval in the absence of the Reeve.

Coming Into Force

This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.
