The RM of Beaver River has been approved for authorization under the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP). The RM of Beaver River is an eligible assistance area for eligible losses and damages to public and/or private property due to Flooding on June 5, 2020. ## Saskatchewan Day Holiday

It was first proposed on March 17, 1975 by Gordon Snyder, Saskatchewan's minister of labour at the time.

"Our prairie winters are usually harsh and long; our summers, while lovely and warm, are unfortunately quite short," Snyder said.

"Saskatchewan Day instead will be another occasion on which Saskatchewan families can gather together to enjoy our great outdoors." Snyder said.

**Hopefully it will also inspire us to pause, Mr. Speaker, and reflect upon our own good fortune to share in that peaceful prosperous land that we call Saskatchewan.- G.T. Snyder**

The order was approved in June 1975 and the first official Saskatchewan Day happened a few weeks later.

### MR CIL Funding for pickle ball courts

At their regular meeting on June 18<sup>th</sup> Council made a resolution to donate \$10,000.00 of Municipal Reserve Cash in Lieu funds to the restoration of the Outdoor Goodsoil Recreation Facilities north of the Goodsoil School.

What is MR CIL? Sometimes for subdivisions, dedication may be met by a monetary settlement in lieu of land. When this occurs, the subdivision applicant pays the municipality cash in lieu of providing land for municipal reserve. The payment must be equivalent to the value of the land that would have been dedicated. These funds are put into a special savings account for such Community projects.



## Sign Up For Your Clubroot Soil Test Today

DNA-based testing can be used to detect low levels of the clubroot pathogen. Early detection and proactive clubroot management strategies can be used to keep spore levels low and minimize yield losses.

To encourage testing, SaskCanola and the Ministry of Agriculture are offering fall clubroot soil testing to producers across the province. Taking part in this program has value for you as an individual producer, and also provides value for your fellow Saskatchewan canola producers. The \$100-value of this test is covered by SaskCanola.
