

BYLAW No. 09- 20

**A BYLAW OF THE R.M. OF BEAVER RIVER No. 622 TO AMEND
BYLAW No. 58 KNOWN AS THE BASIC PLANNING STATEMENT**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Beaver River No. 622, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 58 as follows:

- 1. **PART III RESIDENTIAL LAND USE, 3.3 Single Parcel Country Residential Policy, a) Locational Guidelines**, is amended by deleting clause i) and replacing it with the following:

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- i) A maximum of four country residential parcels per quarter section, containing a country residence or farmstead, will be allowable for subdivision, and use will be regulated by the applicable zoning district. Density greater than four country residential parcels per quarter, shall be deemed “intensive” and shall require redesignation and rezoning as per the provisions of this bylaw. Subdivision and subsequent development will be allowed, subject to the following setback conditions:”

This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval of the Minister of Government Relations.
