

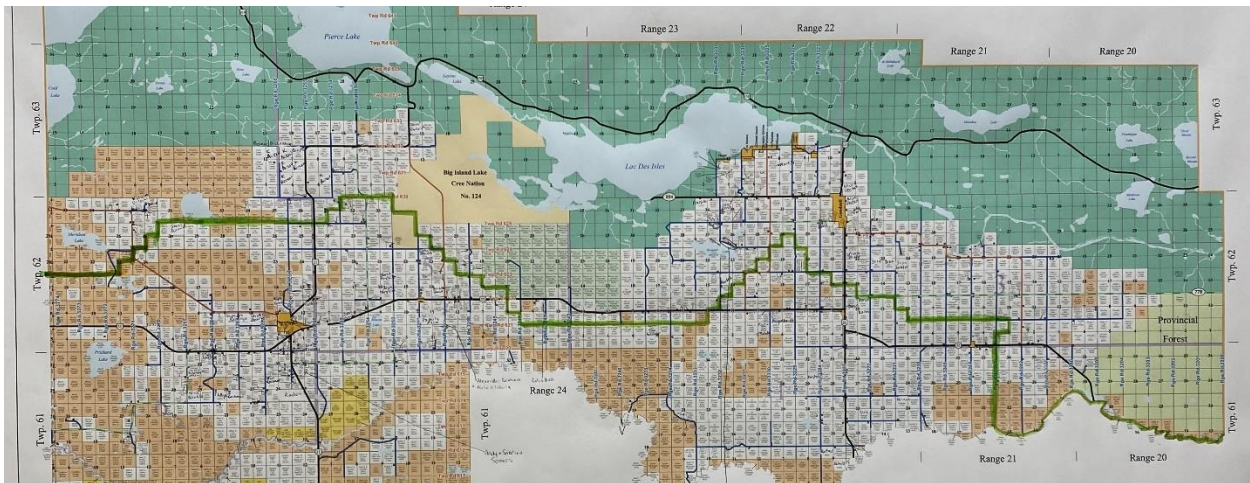
## Fire Ban Clarification for the RM of Beaver River

As of May 17, 2023 10:00 am

Due to hot, dry conditions and an extreme fire risk that covers most of northern Saskatchewan, the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency (SPSA) has issued a provincial fire ban for Crown lands, provincial parks and the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District, effective immediately.

The fire ban includes any open fires, controlled burns and fireworks.

This provincial fire ban supersedes the RM Level 1 ban in that a fire ban in a provincial park includes any quarter section wholly or partly within 4.5 km of a provincial park or provincial forest. The areas north of the green highlighted line on the following map indicate the included area for the provincial fire ban. Please note that this provincial ban includes all lakeshore subdivisions.



From Saskatchewan Parks:

“All open fires are prohibited when restrictions are in place. However, CSA-approved self-contained portable gas heating devices and gas fire pits, barbecues, pressurized stoves and charcoal briquettes will be permitted for cooking at park discretion.”
