Snowploughing

The Snowploughing of Private Drives and Lanes Policy was amended via Council resolution #227-24 at the September 19th meeting. The changes include:

- Flag fee price increased to **\$100.00 per flag** (per service).
- **Bus routes, primary municipal roads and secondary municipal roads are priority. Driveways may be ploughed only AFTER the aforementioned is complete, as time permits.** Furthermore, the property owner acknowledges that on occasion, due to unforeseen circumstances, that their laneway may not be ploughed by the Municipality and that they may be required to make alternative arrangements to have the laneways ploughed.

- ♦ an enumerator;
- ♦ a notary public;
- ♦ a commissioner for oaths;
- ♦ any other person authorized to sign oaths; or
- ♦ a lawyer.

Here's how:

Scarefully design your costume: Make sure masks and other accessories don't obstruct sight, and that costumes don't pose a tripping risk. Consider adding reflective tape or a glow stick to costumes or carrying a flashlight.

Carve out a plan: Discuss trick-or-treating rules with kids before they leave the house. For older kids, arrange a route and meeting/check-in times and places.

Use gourd street sense: Stay on sidewalks and cross roads only at intersections or crosswalks when trick-or-treating.

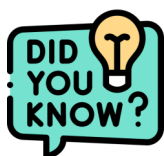
Bone appetit: Check over children's candy hauls before they dive in.

The Meaning of the letter "i" in the names of Apple Gadgets

What does the i symbol actually signify? The tradition of using the letter i in product names at Apple didn't begin with the iPhone but originated much earlier with devices such as the iMac, iBook, iPod and others. The first appearance of the i was in 1998 in the name of the iMac. The abbreviation is for internet, with the new computer's ability to connect to the World Wide Web as it's main feature. At that time, in 1998, internet connectivity was a highly innovative feature. Since then, the company has incorporated the i into the names of many Apple products. The iPhone name carried the same meaning as in the first iMac because of the ability to access the internet from a mobile device in 2007 was envisioned by Apple as revolutionary.
