Re: Calcium Chloride application for dust control

The R.M. has been discussing the feasibility of applying calcium chloride to roads for dust control. This would involve one application of calcium chloride at a rate of 400m x 5m x 2L. Cost for the chloride would be \$1,600.00, with the R.M. paying for 50% and the ratepayer paying the other 50%. The required fees will have to be paid for in advance by the ratepayer if they want the service.

If the project goes ahead, it would be done in the spring/summer of 2026.

Do you own or lease agricultural land in an adjoining municipality?

(RM of Meadow Lake #588 or RM of Loon Lake #561)

If so, you may be eligible to receive a municipal tax exemption on your permanent residential dwelling as per section 293 of The Municipalities Act (residential dwelling cannot be located in an organized or unorganized hamlet).

You must fill out the prescribed form called the "Land Owned or Under Lease Agreement in Adjoining Municipalities". It must be completed with the other RM Administrator's Authorization Signature. You must return the form to the RM of Beaver River's office on or before **March 31st ANNUALLY** to be eligible for this exemption.

Applicants:

This tender is to supply the following maintenance services for the RM of Beaver River No. 622 every Saturday, Sunday and all statutory holidays (Friday and Monday holidays only) for the period commencing on May 15, 2026 to September 7, 2026 inclusive:

1. RM West Boat Launch (NE 12-63-23-W3) / RM East Boat Launch (SE 17-63-22-W3):
 - a. Washrooms
 - must be cleaned and bleached daily
 - empty and remove garbage daily (haul to RM waste collection site)
 - refill paper products as required
 - cleaning products and paper products will be supplied by RM
 - monitor septic tank daily and notify RM when pump out is necessary
 - b. Fish Filleting Shack
 - must be cleaned and bleached daily
 - cleaning supplies will be supplied by the RM
 - empty and remove garbage daily (haul to RM waste collection site)
 - remove and haul away fish offal daily to RM waste collection site

Do you rent agricultural land within the RM of Beaver River?

If so, and you wish to receive a municipal tax exemption on your permanent residential dwelling (as per Section 293 of The Municipalities Act) you must provide the rental agreement and written notice, signed by the owner, stating that the owner has agreed that the lessee is to receive the exemption. The letter must indicate the land location of the rental property. The rental agreement or letter must be submitted to the RM of Beaver River's office on or before **March 31st ANNUALLY** to be eligible for this exemption.
